COURSE REQUIREMENTS FOR TALAWANDA ONLINE:

- All students must attend an orientation session on June 13th, 2011 beginning at 8:00am at THS in room 106. Students will be assigned to orientation session A or B based on enrollment numbers.
- ALL STUDENTS REPEATING CLASSES WILL HAVE MANDATORY CLASS SESSIONS THEY MUST ATTEND. Class sessions will be from 8-10 or 10-12 Monday thru Friday.
- THS Students taking courses for advancement can work at home or at THS, but middle school students in the program MUST WORK AT THS.
- Students will be given weekly goals for each class. Attendance will be taken daily based on time logged-on and material completed.
- Students can work at home any time after Noon. This program will allow only 15 people to log on at the same time.
- Students must take final exams in the computer lab at THS during designated time no later than July 1st. All courses and final exams must be completed by this date.
- Complete the required course work in the allotted time - 3 weeks for a semester credit.
- Failure to meet any of the requirements listed above will result in the student failing the course. No refund of registration fees will be made for failure to complete a course. Students can complete course work (other than final exam) on a computer at home or can use a computer in the designated computer lab from 8:00am - noon on Monday through Friday. Students will have the option to Email teachers with questions.

TRANSPORTATION

Please note that the district will not provide transportation for summer school.

ATTENDANCE

A single day in summer school is the equivalent to one full week of regular school. Only personal illness accompanied by a doctor's note will count as an excused absence, and all work must be made up if credit is to be received. AFTER 2 DAYS OF UNEXCUSED ABSENCE AND NO DOCTOR'S NOTE THERE WILL BE NO REFUND ISSUED
