Kindergarten

1 – backpack (no wheels) (large enough to hold 9x13 folder) labeled with your child's name. No mini backpacks designed for preschoolers!

1 – school box - label the box with your child's name

1 – container of playdoh (not fundoh)

2 – box of 24 Crayola crayons

2 – pack of 10 Crayola markers – primary colors

1 – box of tissues

1 bottle of Elmer's liquid glue 4 oz.

2 pocket folders any color/design - no prongs label with child's name

2 – skinny dry erase markers - black only - **Currier & Davidson's**

Class only

1 package of white index cards - 5x7 size

1 – set of headphones in a labeled Ziploc baggie. No earbuds

BOYS – 1 container of Clorox wipes

GIRLS – 1 container of baby wipes

Remember, your child will need a pair of non-marking gym shoes, and an oversized t-shirt with your child's name on it for art.
