Coming to the Hamilton Lane Library this Summer!

The Hamilton Lane Library will soon be home to one of the 2023 StreetSpark outdoor murals. StreetSpark is a public art program that creates engagement by producing high quality art, providing opportunities for local artists and enhancing the visual appeal of Hamilton. The mural will be placed on the north side of the building next to the parking lot.



Mural Title: *Stream of Consciousness*

This mural design shows the Great Miami river as a young girl with flowing water as hair and a large book open in her hands. Emanating out of the book are cloud-like vignettes that show various STEM concepts and careers like circuitry, entomology, botany, math, astronauts (Ohio has produced so many!) and engineering. Viewers can find new details to enjoy each time they visit the library.

About the designer: Anissa is an artist, organizer, and musician in Cincinnati, Ohio. She makes optimistic and bold art honoring memory, nature, community, and identity. She believes in the power of illustration and public art to explain, emphasize, remind, celebrate and encourage.

She is currently a Mural Studio Manager at ArtWorks, and an adjunct professor at the Art Academy of Cincinnati. Anissa also helps run Girls Rock Cincinnati, a non-profit that fuels joy through art & music for girls and gender-expansive youth, and writes music in a band called Wavelette.

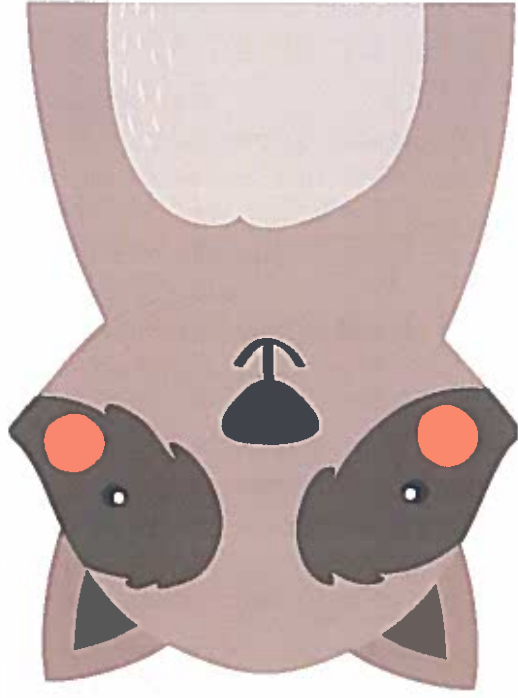
