You can drop off at the RED Triangle located on the map near the entrance. THS Parking will be in Lot 6. Overflow parking will be in Lot 1 closest to B. Street where the arrow is at.

- Lot 1: Sports complex, outdoor turf, tournaments (Enter from Rhea)
- Lot 2: Orthopedic Associates of SW Ohio
- Lot 3: Fitness Center members and Warehouse Hotel guests only
- Lot 5: Champion Mill Conference Center event parking
- Lot 6: Champion Mill Conference Center event parking and Lot 1 overflow

Who Can Attend the Dance

*Talawanda 11th and 12th graders

*An 11/12th grader can bring a guest who is in 10th, 11th, or 12th grade from Talawanda or other schools

(If bringing a guest, you must fill out a guest form and have that turned into the office by April 26th to be able to get a CODE)

*Can't be 21 years of age - 20 years old is ok, just can't turn 21 before the dance
