Parking spaces are limited. Availability will be based on the order of applications received with **NO OUTSTANDING SCHOOL FEES**. Students must have their driver license. No one with a temporary license will get a parking spot.

I request the privilege of driving to school. If my request is approved, I agree to comply with the following rules and regulations:

1. To apply for a parking permit, a student must bring the following to the Main Office:
 - a. **NO OUTSTANDING SCHOOL FEES**
 - b. A valid Ohio Driver's license
 - c. Vehicle registration
 - d. \$50.00

2. If another student is illegally parked in your assigned space, please:
 - a. Park in a visitor's space only.
 - b. Report the violation to the Main Office.
 - c. Do not park in another student's assigned space, as that would make the problem worse.

3. The following conditions apply to student parking permits:
 - a. A student must be an everyday driver in order to be issued a parking permit.
 - b. Student parking permits are not transferable.
 - c. No Student may use a permit registered to another student.
 - d. Student may only park in their assigned parking spot. Parking in other areas may result in disciplinary actions.
 - e. If there is a change in license plate or vehicle, it must be reported immediately.
 - f. If your permit is lost or stolen, you must report this to the Main Office.
 - g. The permit must be displayed at all times while vehicle is on THS property.
 - h. The use of a falsified permit will result in disciplinary action for all students involved.

4. All school rules and regulations apply to your vehicle while on school grounds. The following regulations especially apply:
 - a. The parking area is off limits during school hours.
 - b. Your vehicle cannot be used during the school day to transport you and/or other persons off the school grounds (this also includes lunch periods).
 - c. Authorized personnel can search a vehicle on the Talawanda High parking lot if it is believed to contain contraband and/or items, which could be harmful or dangerous to the successful operation of the education process.
 - d. Operation of the motor vehicle that is deemed to be reckless or unsafe while on school property will result in appropriate disciplinary action and potential loss of parking privilege.
 - e. Violations of the code of conduct can result in immediate revocation of parking privileges.
 - f. All drivers must comply with State of Ohio and City of Oxford motor vehicle regulations while on school property. Noncompliance will result in loss of parking privilege.
5. If for any reason parking privileges are revoked for rule violations, no refunds will be granted.
6. The Talawanda City School District is not responsible for any theft, vandalism, or damage to any vehicle or its contents. All students park at their own risk.
7. Students are expected to report any inappropriate parking, assigned space violations, or unauthorized visitors to the Main Office.
